## WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

We are going to work our way into our reading curriculum between now and Labor Day. We will work on building our reading and writing stamina back up as well as working on our basic phonics skills before we jump into spelling.

The same deal will go for math. We will ease back into those practices and routines with reviewing concepts and playing games in preparation for our first unit on place value.

Science and Social studies alternates after each unit. We will begin the year on science with life cycles of plants and growing our own bean plants. That will begin within the first few weeks.

As we begin religion for the year, we are going to focus on Theology of the Body. This is an understanding of what it means to be human and how we are created in the image and likeness of God.
