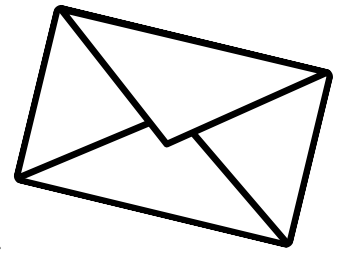




# WEEKLY
