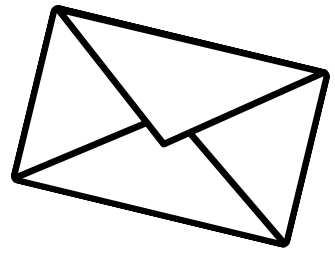

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING
