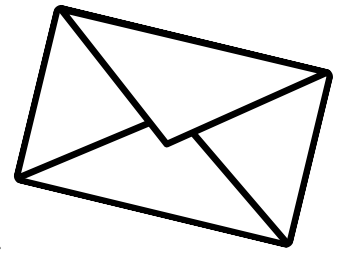

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Our essential question this week in reading is: "How do people from different cultures contribute to a community?". We will work on asking and answering questions as well as sequencing stories. Our first writing project on personal narratives is beginning as well.

Our first math chapter will help us review place value and rounding. This week we will practice ordering numbers and rounding to the nearest 10's and 100's.

We have been tracking the growth of our beans this week while continuing to study the similarities between plant and animal life cycles. This week we move onto studying social and group behavior. We are studying the question: "How can living in a group help or hurt an animal's chances of survival?"

We are continuing on with Theology of the Body. The topic this week stretches over many days. It is:
